Visa Information

For differing nationalities please check your visa requirements before travel and feel free to contact our team if you have questions.*

Thailand

American, Australian, Austrian, British, Canadian, German, Irish, Italian, Lithuanian, Netherlands, New Zealand, Polish, Portuguese, Spanish passport holders may enter Thailand up to 30 days without a visa. Please note that the passports should have at least 6 months remaining validity and the additional docs maybe asked at the customs. Also note that the length of the permitted stay may change if entering through landborders. For the detailed and the most up-to-date information, please contact the nearest Thailand embassy.

Laos

For most travelers 30-day visas are available at the tour entry point at **Luang Prabang Airport** – please note that those holding a passport from certain African, South-Asian and Middle Eastern countries may not be eligible for visa-on-arrival. You'll be allowed to stay in Laos for 14-30 days depending on your nationality - The Dragon Trip tour in Laos is 6 days.

To collect your visa at Visa-On-Arrival office, you will need 35 – 50 USD in cash along with one or two visa photos with white background – visa fee varies for different nationalities. On the weekends, Laos public holidays, before 8am and after 4pm on weekdays, there is a \$1 overtime fee.

You can apply online for a single-entry E-Visa on the Laos Immigration website (<https://laoevisa.gov.la/>). The E-Visa is valid for 30 days and usually processed within three working days unless there is a problem with your application. The online application fee is between \$31 to \$45 depending on your nationality.



Please note that the passports should have at least 6 months remaining validity and the additional docs may be asked at the customs. For the detailed and the most up-to-date information, please contact the nearest Laos embassy.

Vietnam

Germany, France, Italy, Spain, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Russia, Japan, South Korea, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Finland, & Belarus passport holders traveling for tourism to Vietnam have had their permissible stay duration upped, from 15 to 45 days without a visa

Please note that if you are under the visa exemption program (45-day visa-free), leave Vietnam, and wish to re-enter, you can get a new visa exemption of 45 more days upon the new arrival.

Apart from citizens of these thirteen countries (as reference above), **all the other nationalities** are required to have visa to enter Vietnam for tourism purposes regardless of the length of the stay.

You can apply online for a single or multi-entry E-Visa on the Vietnam Immigration website (<https://evisa.xuatnhapcanh.gov.vn/>).

The E-Visa is valid for 90 days and usually processed within three working days. **However, it may take longer and it is suggested to apply earlier.**

Use of the E-visa is limited to certain entry/exit points which you must select at the time of application (The Dragon Trip Tour enters Vietnam in **Hanoi - Noi Bai Int Airport** and exits at the **Moc Bai land border**).

Please note that the passports should have at least 6 months remaining validity and the additional docs may be asked at the customs. For the detailed and the most up-to-date information, please contact the nearest Vietnam embassy.

Cambodia

All Nationalities – 30-day visas are available at the tour entry point at **Bavet** is \$35 for the Government and \$5 service fee. The total is \$40 in cash along with 1 passport-sized photo. (Entry point **Bavet land border** and exits at **Poipet land border** in Cambodia and finally, re-entry **Aranyaprathet land border** in **Thailand**)

Currently, travelers can apply e-visa online (<https://www.evisa.gov.kh/>). The total is \$36 by a valid credit card (Visa/MasterCard) with a recent passport-size photo in digital format (JPEG or PNG format).

Please note that the passports should have at least 6 months remaining validity and the additional docs may be asked at the customs. For the detailed and the most up-to-date information, please contact the nearest Cambodia embassy.
